Weekly Update Videos: Tips

- 1. Keep it real.
- 2. Add value.
- 3. Use it to **contextualise** your subject in the real world. Eg: did anyone see the case handed down by the NSW Court of Appeal last week? It relates to what we are reading in module....
- 4. **Translate** for the student where they are up to in session and what they should be thinking about for successful study (eg: we are 6 weeks out from the exam, you should be preparing good review notes on...)
- 5. Give **clear directions** (location in your subject) on where to find things that will support your students—being conscious of the study cycle. Eg: mindmaps
- 6. Use it to **explain your methodology**, eg: the reason I want you to attempt the problem questions I have set this week on the discussion board are.."
- 7. Use it to help students to **make the connection** between content, tute attendance and assessment.
